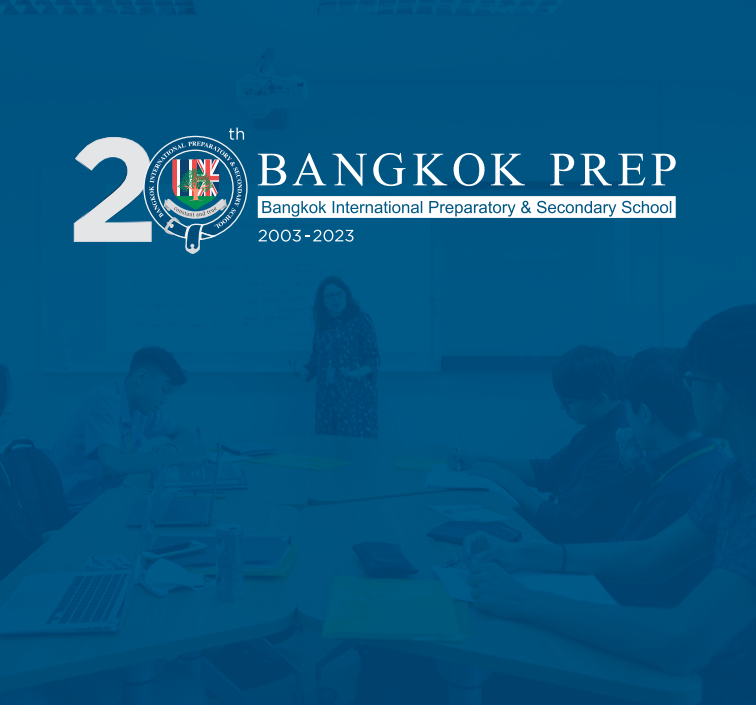

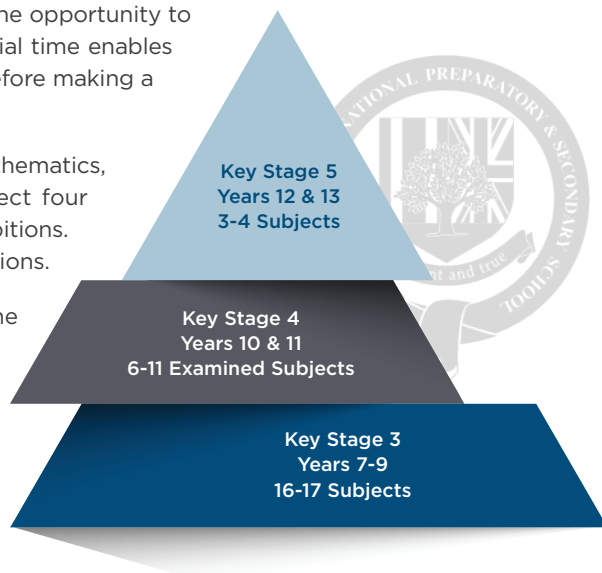
CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

Key Stage 3 is an exciting time for students because it allows them the opportunity to explore and try a broad-range of courses over three years. This crucial time enables them to obtain hands-on experience which lays a solid foundation before making a personalised selection of classes in IGCSEs.

During **Key Stage 4**, students will continue their core subjects (Mathematics, English, Sciences, etc.), but also are given the opportunity to select four additional subjects which are based on their interests and future ambitions. At the completion of Year 11, they will sit for their final **IGCSE** examinations.

During the final two years of Secondary education, students have the choice of selecting three to four **A Levels**, **BTEC** or a **combination of both**. This stage allows students to specialise into the subjects they care most about which leads to higher levels of engagement and excited students.

We follow a collaborative approach for **university preparation** with students and parents. We have a team dedicated to providing counselling, workshops, and events to ensure students are prepared for university applications and selections.

We know our students are so much more than their grades, but we want to congratulate everyone who sat IGCSEs and A Levels this year.

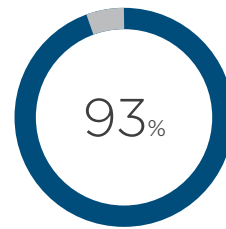
A Level

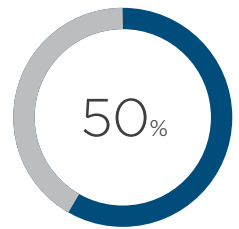
- **61%** of the A Level qualifications that our students earned were awarded at A* - B

These results have secured places in world class universities and many of the best undergraduate courses in the world.

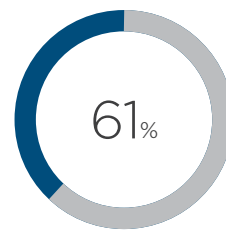

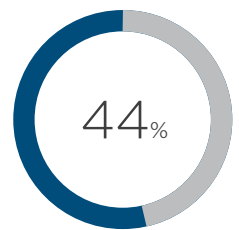
OF ALL **IGCSE** GRADES WERE A*-C

BUSINESS AND TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION COUNCIL (BTEC)

WHAT IS BTEC?

BTEC Nationals are Level 3 qualifications that provide specialist, work-related learning in a range of sectors (Business, IT, Music, Travel and Tourism and Sport) that students need to progress along their chosen learning and career paths.

WHY BTEC?

- BTEC provides a way for students to learn through practical work as well as study.
- There is no big examination at the end of a BTEC course. Students are assessed regularly and awarded marks towards their final grade.

TRANSFERABLE SKILLS LEARNT IN BTEC COURSES

- **Cognitive/Problem solving skills**

EXTENDED PROJECT QUALIFICATION (EPQ) & COMMUNITY SERVICE

HERE AT BANGKOK PREP

Our Sixth Form students explore independently through their EPQ and are involved in continuous development including Community Service, charity work, R U OK? etc.

WHAT IS EPQ?

Universities and employers highly value a student's ability to research and analyse material independently. Promoting independent learning is also central to the ethos of the AQA and is gained through the Enhanced Project Qualification (EPQ). Top universities around the world have been known to prefer students that have completed the EPQ.

UNIVERSITY ACCEPTANCE

BTECs are accepted by many universities but it will depend upon which course each student is applying for. It is recommended that students look at individual universities and courses.

However, BTECs are equivalent to A Level grades, as you can see below:

BTECS ARE AWARDED ONE OF THE FOLLOWING GRADES:

- **Distinction*** - equivalent to 56 UCAS points (the same as an A* at A Level)
- **Distinction** - equivalent to 48 UCAS points (the same as an A at A Level)
- **Merit** - equivalent to 32 UCAS points (the same as a C at A Level)
- **Pass** - equivalent to 16 UCAS points (the same as an E at A Level)

EPQ

- All Sixth Form students undertake a personal project.
- It is worth half an A Level.
- Students choose either a long essay, an event or designing and making a product.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

- Bangkok Prep students plan and prepare to teach students from asylum learning centres.
- Fundraising to improve the facilities at the learning centres.
