



Sixth Form Programme (Entry August 2026)

Students must, prior to starting on their higher-level Secondary School education, be academically ready and prepared to undertake a rigorous course of studies leading to the award of A Level and/or BTEC at Bangkok Prep.

Eligibility

The requirements to take A Level and/or BTEC courses will be based on either their grades from previous external examinations (IGCSE, GCSE) and/or by undertaking entrance examinations in the subjects that they wish to continue with for the coming academic year. All students are required to submit previous academic reports and external examination grades.

The minimum requirement to take three A Levels is five C grade GCSEs. In most subjects a minimum of a B is required at GCSE to take the A Level, some subjects may accept a C. However, a B is preferred to ensure students have the best chance of success. We only recommend four A Levels for students who have achieved A-A* grades in all subjects, however we take into consideration where they want to go to university as some degree courses require four A Levels.

Subject Blocking – August 2026

Applicants need to make **three to four subject choices** from the A - E blocks, and only one choice per block. Most students choose three subjects to study. Students wishing to study four subjects must discuss with the Head of Sixth Form to gain approval.

In addition to these subjects, there are **compulsory** components for all Year 12 students:

- Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) – for most students
- Physical Education (for overall health and wellbeing)
- Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) Education
- Thai studies
- Futures - Guidance & support for university/career pathways
- Enrichment- Students have the freedom to choose Elective Enrichment sessions tailored to their goals and interests (e.g. Student Leadership, Human Rights workshops, personal projects, Primary ECA leadership, etc.)

Students will also have opportunities, organized by the school, to benefit from counselling and tutoring programmes as needed. Furthermore, we support internships with local industry as well as contributing to the community through our Community Service programme, to support students' entry into world-renowned universities.
