KEY STAGE 4

(IGCSEs - YEARS 10-11)

During Key Stage 4, students will continue their core subjects (Mathematics, English), Sciences (Physics, Chemistry, Biology), PE, PSHE, and Thai Studies, but also are given the opportunity to select four additional subjects which are based on their interests and future ambitions. At the completion of Year 11, they will sit for their final IGCSE examinations.

SIXTH FORM

(YEARS 12-13)

During the final two years of Secondary education, students have the choice of selecting three to four A Levels, BTEC or a combination of both.

Advanced level qualifications (known as A Levels) are subject-based qualifications that can lead to university, further study, training, or work.

BTEC courses are Level 3 qualifications that provide specialist, work-related learning in a range of sectors (Business, IT, Music, Sport, Travel and Tourism).

The ability to create a specialised pathway allows students to explore what they care about most, leading to greater engagement and a more fulfilling academic experience.

In addition to their chosen subjects, there are compulsory components for all students:

- Extended Project Qualification (EPQ)
- Physical Education (for overall health and well-being)
- Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) Education
- Enrichment - Independent projects to enhance student learning
- Thai studies
- Futures - Guidance & support for university/ career pathways

WHAT IS EPQ?

Universities and employers highly value a student's ability to research and analyse material independently. Promoting independent learning is also central to the ethos of the AQA and is gained through the Enhanced Project Qualification (EPQ). Top universities around the world have been known to prefer students that have completed the EPQ.

- It is worth half an A Level.
- Students choose either a long essay, an event or design and make a product.

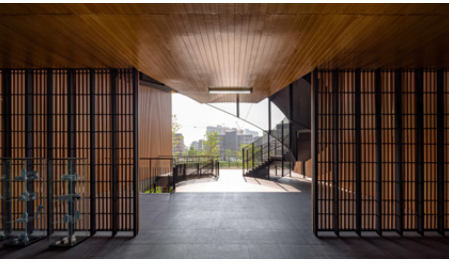
